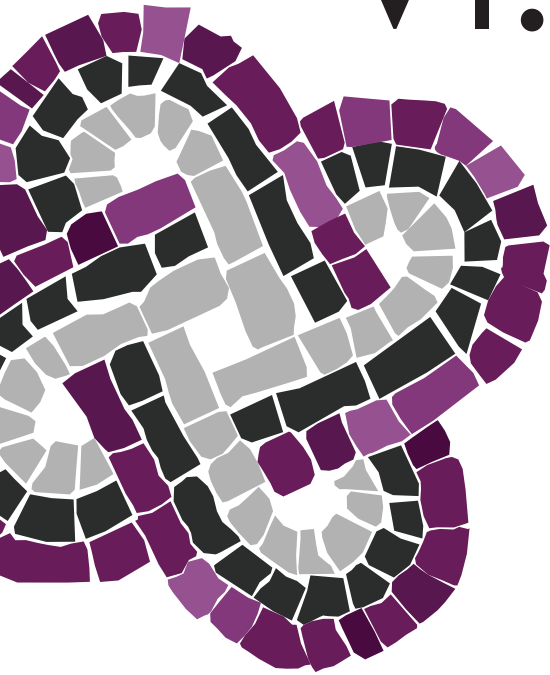

The 5th edition of the International Summer School organized by the **Accessibility Lab Network** focuses on the issue of **accessibility to Cultural Heritage**



The school main goal is to promote the issue of **UD approach** in the design process to enhance cultural heritage and let it accessible to users with different capabilities and needs; **the aim** is to conduct activities in the field of **design project, education, communication** and **specific training for young professionals** concerning **accessibility to cultural heritage and its value.**

The 5th edition also give space to issues related to **UD approach to teaching and learning**, with a special focus on the use of technology in an innovative way

A design workshop will tight together topics that the modules will focus on, targeted to different participants:

MODULE 1

This module addresses students in architecture and engineering courses from partner Universities, and it will focus on the design project to support the access to heritage in its material and immaterial values, basing on the inclusive design approach.

The result will be a set of key elements that must be considered when approaching the project for inner and outdoor spaces and path in cultural sites. A preliminary design project will be produced on a case study.

MODULE 2

This module focuses on new technologies and support for knowledge, to foster the discovery and achieving of values from cultural sites.

The result of the workshops will be guidelines to foster creativity through different means – like audiovisual, interview, narration, modelling – to approach the knowledge of a cultural site and specific solution will be draft for the case study.

MODULE 3

This module focuses on issue of UD approach for teaching and design of learning environment, and it will involve the National **Conference of Rector's Delegates for Disability at the Universities (CNUDD)**.

ICT based technologies will be focused on, to foster the learning process for students with disabilities, and the workshop will concerned the effectiveness of pedagogical approach based on the use of multiple means to support higher education.
